- Ka'ba on Earth Ka'ba in Heavens, Bare, Multi-coloured & Black Kiswa, Had window and two doors, Hateem is part of Ka'ba, not cube shape originally – Hajr e Aswad broken into several pieces, held ransom for several years

- At-Taaif 100 km, 6000 ft altitude, Prophet SAW walked there to gather support for Islam and invite people. He was abused and attacked. Abdullah ibn Abbas RA Masjid, Maqaam and other Companions.
- أللهم Prophet SAW did dua for him at his brith, and his Tahneek and Dua علمه الكتاب و الفقه
- Nearby is orchard where the Prophet SAW rested and Zaid bin Harith tended to his wounds, there he prayed to Allah & said no to the angel of mountains. Here is the Masjid where he rested his head and did Da'wah to the people, opposite is Masjid of Imam Ali where he came.

- Banu Sa'd 150 km from Makkah, Haleema Saadiyah, the suckling mother of the Prophet SAW. He stayed 3 years + 2 years with Sayyidah Haleema. This is the place where his heart was opened and purified.
- Whole Qur'an is full of Maqamaat to strengthen your connection to places people and time. Yusuf, Sulayman, Ibraheem, Nuh, Musa, Sacred sites places

- Angels descended with Gibrael wearing Yellow Pagriyan. Gibrael Aqdim Hayzoom - horse name
- The munafiqs and mushriks who were killed, the Prophet SAW said

هل وجدتم ما وعدكم الله حقا

 Companions said do these dead hear – as much as you hear, so do they.

- Abwa 250 km north Makkah. The Prophet SAW 6 / 6.5 years Placed his face on his mothers chest and started crying "You're leaving the dunya, what will happen to me "O my son a mother whose given the world a son like you will never die." Umme Ayman went to the local village and said Abdul Muttalibs family member has passed away so come and bury her. She said don't bury her on the path or roadway but bury her high - So they did on the mountain top After a jang and passed by Abwa and stopped and went to grave Cried profusely Aisha asked why you crying he said my mother is buried here and I couldn't control myself.
- Quba, 1/2 weeks stayed here, laid foundation, 2 nafls = full Umrah He SAW would come each Wednesday walking or by ride
