Principles Of Islamic Life

- Freedom of Religion: لَا إِكْرَاهَ فِي الدِّين There shall be no compulsion in [acceptance of] the religion. (2:256)
- Freedom of Practice: لَكُمْ دِينُكُمْ وَلِيَ دِين For you is your religion, and for me is my religion. (109:6)
- Respect for Humanity: يَا أَيُّهَا النَّاسُ إِنَّا حَلَقْنَاكُم مِّن ذَكَرٍ وَأُنثَىٰ وَجَعَلْنَاكُمْ شُعُوبًا O mankind, indeed We have created you from male and وَقَبَائِلَ لِتَعَارَفُوا female and made you peoples and tribes that you may know one another. (49:13)
- Peace Coexistence: وَلَا تُلْقُوا بِأَيْدِيكُمْ إِلَى التَّهْلُكَةِ وَأَحْسنُوا and do not fall into ruin with your own hands; and be virtuous; (2:195) وَلَا تُفْسِدُوا فِي الْأَرْضِ And do not spread turmoil in the earth after its reform, (7:56)
