"So stand firm and straight as you are commanded and those who are with you and do not sway" Ibn Abbas said: "There was no verse in the Qur'an harder on the Prophet than this verse." Imam Muslim reported that a man said "O Messenger of Allah; tell me something of Islam, which I will not ask anyone else about it. He said:

"Say, I believe in Allah and then be steadfast." - قُلْ آمَنْتُ بِاللَّهِ فَاسْتَقِمْ

- Imam Al-Nawawi said: "This hadith is one of the great ones that Islam is based on." To be steadfast is to abide by Islam in totality of what you know. Sayyidna Umar الله said: "Steadfast is enjoining what is good and forbidding what is evil, and not deceit, like the deceit of the fox"

  المُعْمَلُونَ الْحَنَّةُ بِمَا كُنتُمْ تَعْمَلُونَ Enter Paradise for what you used to do." (16:332)
- Our Deen, is a **Deen of Doing, a Deen of Action**. Islam is not how much Qur'an or how many Hadith you know. Islam is putting whatever we know into **Practice**. The Prophet **taught the Deen to his Companions** carefully in amounts that they would be able to understand and practice. Hence why even the Qur'an was revealed over a 23 years.

• Knowledge is abundant, but its application is scarce. Muadh Ibn Jabal anarrates that the Prophet said - "I have no fear for you with regard to what you do not know. Rather you must look to how you put what you do know into action." The Prophet feared his Umma would become like those of the of the Bani Isra'il, about whom Allah say

The example of those who were entrusted with the Torah and then did not take it on is like that of a donkey who carries volumes [of books].
