• Knowledge is abundant, but its application is scarce. Muadh Ibn Jabal narrates that the Prophet said - "I have no fear for you with regard to what you do not know. Rather you must look to how you put what you do know into action." The Prophet feared his Umma would become like those of the of the Bani Isra'il, about whom Allah say

The example of those who were entrusted with the Torah and then did not take it on is like that of a donkey who carries volumes [of books].

The great men of the Sahabah understood this implicitly and so they took great care to only learn what they could implement in their own lives. Umar ibn al-Khattab 🐞 spent twelve years memorising Surah al-Baqarah and with every ayah that he learned he made sure that he had fully put into practice before moving on to the next one. Otherwise it is just words and information. Al-Walid ibn Uqba 🐞 narrates that the Prophet 🎕 said "People from the Garden will look across to people from the Fire and ask them, 'How did you end up in the Fire? For, by Allah, we ourselves only got into the Garden because of what you taught us.' They will reply, 'We used to say but not do.'"

Therefore remain firm the way you are commanded to, and those who have turned along with you (11:112)

"Say, I believe in Allah and then be steadfast" - قُلْ آمَنْتُ بِاللَّهِ فَاسْتَقِمْ

Enter Paradise for what you used to do." (16:332) ادْخُلُوا الْجَنَّةَ بِمَا كُنتُمْ تَعْمَلُونَ

Our Deen, is a Deen of Doing, a Deen of Action. Islam is not how much Qur'an or how many Hadith you know. Islam is putting whatever we know into Practice. The Prophet taught the Deen to his Companions carefully in amounts that they would be able to understand and practice. Hence why even the Qur'an was revealed over a 23 years.
