We stand at the end of one great Islamic Year, 1439, and we ask Allah to accept all our efforts and sincere deeds. We also stand at the doors of the new Islamic Year, 1440, we ask Allah to make it a year of goodness, hope, blessings, peace, and security for the Ummah and world.

The Prophet informed us that "Actions Depend on Intentions", but also that the "Acceptance of Actions Depend on their Completion".

If you reflect on the end of this year you will see a connection between its beginning and end. The beginning of our year is with the Hijrah of the Prophet , and it is sealed with the actions of Hajj. Two great journeys towards the acceptance and pleasure of Allah ...

The Hijrah marked the establishment of our Community, Society, and Civilisation, based on Justice, Equality, Honour, Dignity, Respect, Tolerance, Cooperation, Freedom and Rights.

The Hijrah illustrates our obedience to Allah , to remove evil, corruption and replace it with goodness and integrity.

The Hijrah is not simply a movement from one city/country to another, but rather a movement from corruption and sedentary to transparency and effort. From ignorance and selfishness to knowledge, guidance, altruism and honesty.

Our Prophet was a Prophet for Humanity and Messenger of Peace, mercy onto all of creation.

عا أيها الناس – O people, spread peace, feed the hungry and needy, maintain and strengthen ties of kinship, establish the prayer during the night whilst people are asleep and you will enter heaven with ease.

For us especially in this approaching year we must return back to basics and remember the essence of Hijrah which is to move away from and leave all that which Allah is has declared forbidden for you.

المسلم من سلم الناس من لسانه و يده و المهاجر من هاجر ما نهي الله عليه

Real Hijrah is to move away from disobedience and sins and move away from earning haram, doing Haraam, eating and drinking haram.

Abee ibn ka'b, "If the servant of Allah leaves anything for His sake, Allah will substitute it for something far greater and provide for him form means he can never imagine."

So we must perform the physical and spiritual Hijrah with our hearts and souls and not harm Islam or others with our actions and misdeeds.

The Prophet said that "Hijrah will not cease until Tawbah ceases, and Tawbah will not cease until the sun rises from the west."

These are the limits Allah, and whoever obeys Allah and His Messenger will be admitted by Him to gardens [in Paradise] under which rivers flow, abiding eternally therein; and that is the great attainment. (4:13)

And whatever the Messenger has given you - take; and what he has forbidden you - refrain from. (59:7)
