



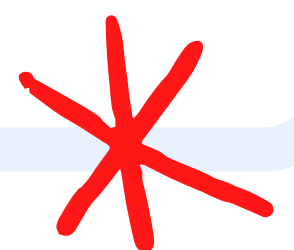

What is the Keffiyeh?

The Keffiyeh is a traditional square shaped cotton scarf. It is a symbol of Palestinian nationalism and holds great meaning.

The Keffiyeh is believed to have originated way back in 300 BC, when the Sumerians and Babylonians wore the cloth to distinguish their honor, or high rank.

Why do Palestinians wear the Keffiyeh?

Palestinians wear the keffiyeh as a symbol of unity and to stand against oppression. It is also worn by people around the world to signify their solidarity with Palestinians.

The Keffiyeh is also worn by farmers and Bedouins as protection from the high desert sun, heat, windswept sand and dust.



Did you know?

The keffiyeh is also called "Kufiya", "Shemagh" or "Hattah".

It is found in many Arab countries such as Palestine, Jordan, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, Iraq, Kuwait, Qatar and Bahrain.

There only remains one factory in the world which continues to weave the only original Keffiyeh made in Palestine: The Hirbawi family in Hebron.

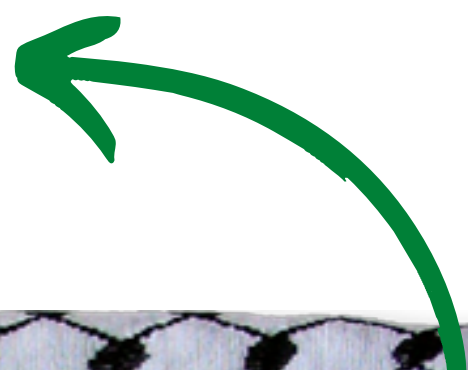

This pattern represents the trade routes going through Palestine of natural and cultural exchange.



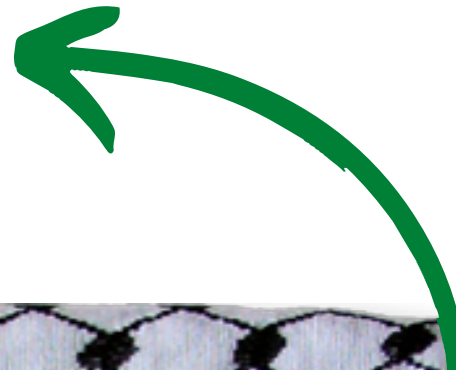

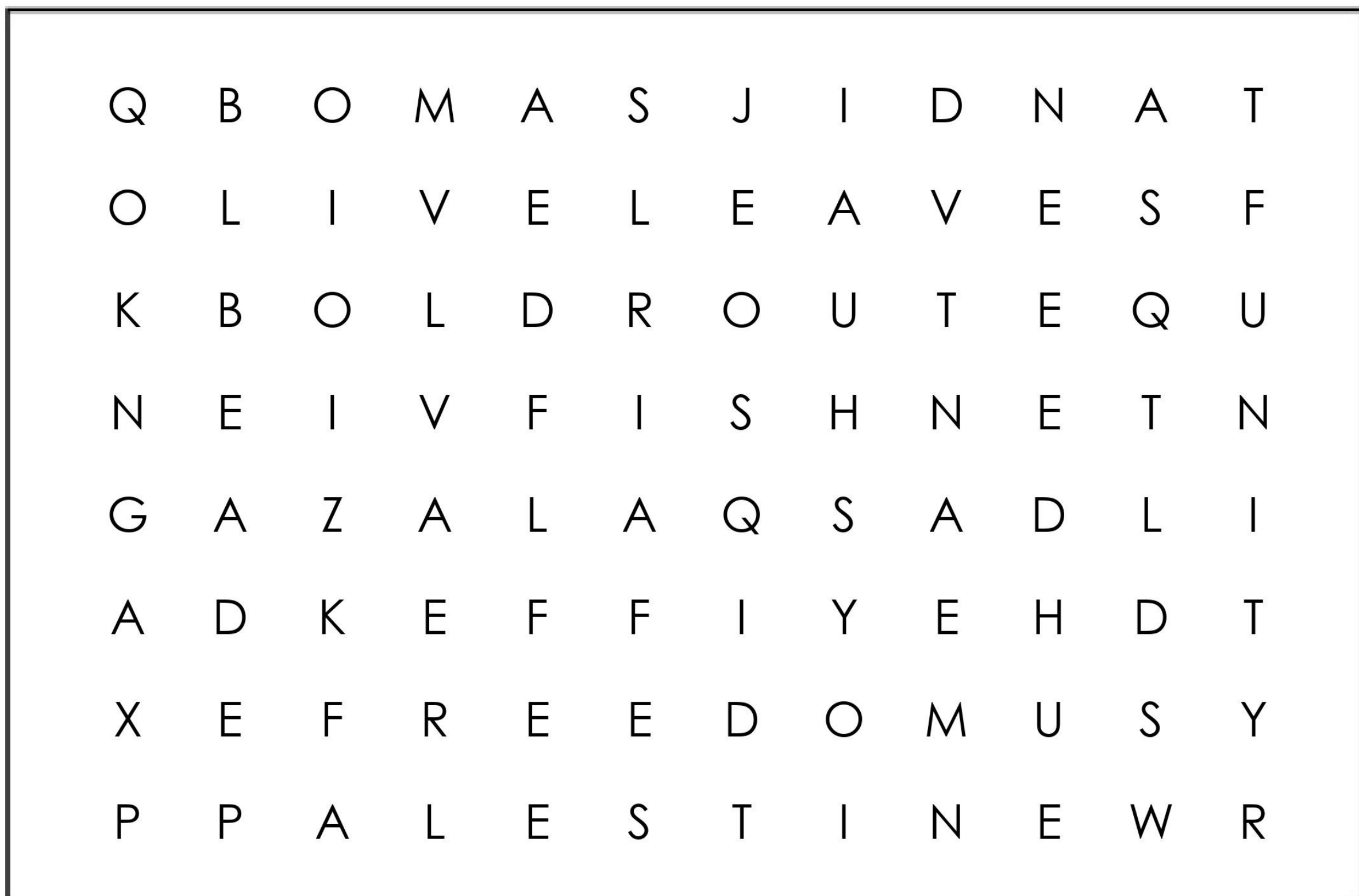
