

# Make the Lapbook



Fold the end of the A3 size paper to meet in the middle, creating doors for your lapbook. Cut and paste the Al Aqsa picture on either door. When you open the lapbook, you will place the pockets and other cut outs.

# Lapbook

You will need

- A3 size cardstock or cardboard
- glue
- scissors
- colouring pencils, crayons or markers

To assemble the lapbook, cut out the pockets below and colour in the Native Palestine Title.

Cut along the black lines of the pockets and fold down along the dashed lines. Glue the flaps down onto the lapbook base making a pocket, the opening will be from the top. The plant, animal and food cards will go into these corresponding pockets.

Complete the activities on the following pages and cut and glue them onto your lapbook.

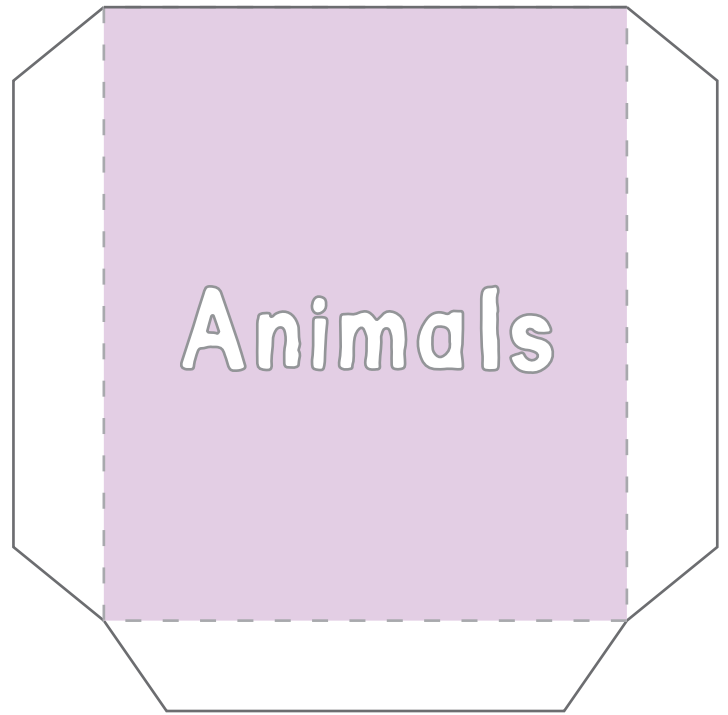
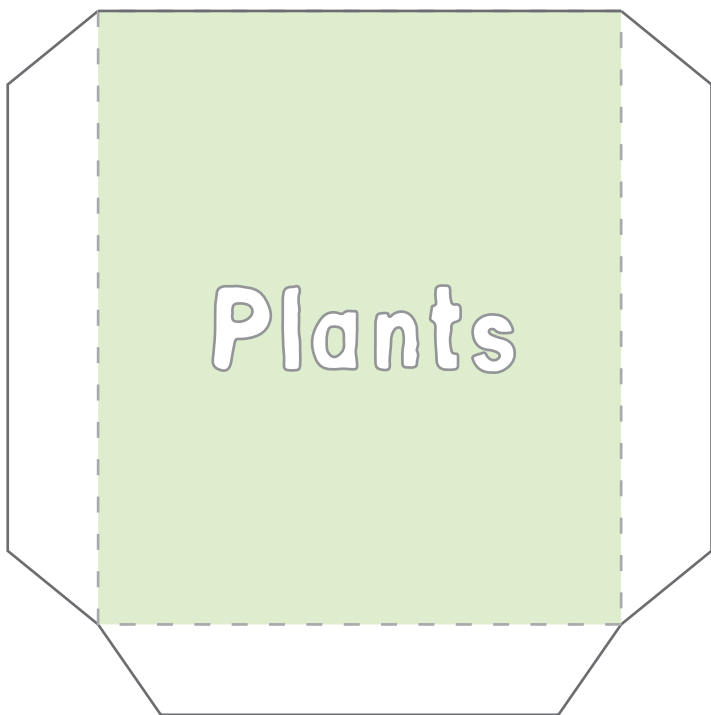

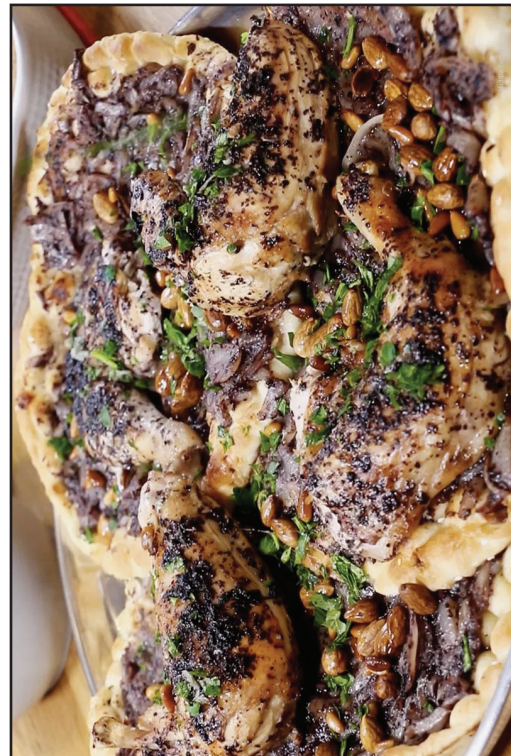


# Cut Out Page for Lapbook
