

#### This is my face.





it is blessed."



HER tongue out at me.






"Yes, that's right," Mum smiled.


#### "So there's 3 SPECIAL PLACES FOR MUSLIMS?

#### CHAPTER 3 - THE NAKBA AND APARTHEID

Dad told us that in 1948,

Israel's military forced

# 800,000 Paléstinians

to leave their homes and run for their lives.

800,000 people is a massive number. If 800,000 people stood in a line, the line would go from my house in London, all the way to Edinburgh in Scotland.



If 800,000 people stood in a straight line it would go almost all the way across the UK.

That's how many people were forced to leave their land. And they're not allowed to come back, even now.

Kind of Reminds me of when I saw a kid in my class getting bumped off his seat by one of the mean kids. The smaller kid just flew off the chair, before the big kid sat on him.

So year, at that time, 450 villages were wiped out and around 15,000 Palestinians were killed. This is called the first catastrophe - THE NAKBA.

AND THEN IN 1967, ISRAEL LAUNCHED ANOTHER WAR AND OCCUPIED GAZA AND THE WEST BANK TOO. THEY INVADED JERUSALEM. THEY MARCHED INTO THE HOLY AL-AQSA COMPLEX AND TOOK CONTROL.



2.3 million people live in this tiny space.

For 17 years, the people here have been locked in. They can't come and go and their electricity and water is controlled. This means they can't get enough food and fuel and people are very poor here. Lots of kids under 18 live here, almost half the population.

# 300,000 more Palestinians lost their homes in 1967.

I figured out I would need 6000 lunch boxes to fit 300,000 marbles.

Basically, the Palestinian people have suffered A LOT, for the last 75 years. I don't know about you, but I think they're like superheroes. The strongest people in the world.

At school, we learnt about **NELSON Mandela** and how he is a hero for fighting apartheid in South Africa. My teacher told me that apartheid is when some people

#### WAIT! WHAT'S THE UN? (6)



- •Tell people what you've learnt here. Shake this with them. We need EVERYONE to know about what happening so they can also have the courage to stop what's happening, like you do!
- ·In the UK and the USA, wear a badge or sticker with the Palestinian flag, to show your support for the Palestinians, even when it's not on the news anymore. Check with your parents before wearing one to school. If you live in other countries, like France and Germany, ask your adults about wearing a flag.
- ·Be creative design and make keyrings, jewellery, t-shirts, paintings, mock-up Aqsa designs, or anything

you want, in support of Palestine and explaining what's happening. You could even sell them with some of the proceeds going to help Palestinians in Gaza and make a little pocket money in the process.


·Give money in charity to Gaza. Get creative with ways to raise money. You could get people to sponsor you for something, or auction some artwork!
