6 ISLAMIC PRINCIPLES OF JUSTICE / SUSTAINABILITY

1. Tawheed (Oneness) The understanding that everything comes from Allah ﷻ and the inter-connection of all living things and their systems.

"To Him belongs what is in the heavens and what is on the earth and what is between them and what is under the soil." (20:6)

2. Ayat (Sign) The ability to see everything in the natural world as a sign of Allah / God / Supreme Being / interconnectedness.

"Indeed, in the creation of the heavens and the earth and the alternation of the night and the day are signs for those of understanding." (3:190)

3. Khaleefah (Steward) The responsibility we have to protecting the natural world and managing it in a sustainable way.

"And it is He who has made you successors upon the earth." (6:165)

4. Amaanah (Trust) Acting as stewards of the natural world & preserving it.

“Indeed, we offered the Trust to the heavens and the earth” (33:72)

5. Adl (Justice) Simply, treating the world with justice & respect. Recognising that everyone can make a difference by changing the way we live.

“Indeed, Allah orders justice and good conduct” (16:90)

6. Mizaan (Balance) The world exists in a natural balance, which is thrown off by pollution, consumption, exploitation, & must be restored.

“ And the heaven He raised and imposed the balance. That you not transgress within the balance.” (55:5-10)

“The best of people are those that bring most benefit to the rest of mankind.”

We all have a common cause; to save the planet. The Prophet ﷺ life was simple, balanced, never extravagant, but sustainable and caring.

Consume less - Conserve more, Care for the environment, Clean Up

Resist the consumerist culture, refrain from being greedy.
