- "I am content with Allah as my Lord, with Muhammad as my Messenger and with Islam as my religion." (Abi Dawud)
- Perfect, Balanced, Structured, Ordered, Regulated Life. As opposed to disordered, imbalanced, and chaotic. Look at the natural & religious laws of Allah, see order, regulation and systematic processes.
- Allah created the universe with characteristics of order & regulation

"He to whom belongs the dominion of the heavens and the earth and who has not taken a son and has not had a partner in dominion and has created each thing and determined it with precise determination." (25:2) "And everything with Him is by due measure." (13:8)

He created planets travelling at precise speeds & orbits

"It is not allowable for the sun to reach the moon, nor does the night overtake the day, but they all float, each within an orbit." (36:40)

Stares in wonder at the universe & reflect on this verse

"You do not see in the creation of the Most Merciful any inconsistency. So look again; do you see any disorder?"(67:3)

- If gravity was stronger, excessive ammonia and methane would collect in the Earth's atmosphere, damaging life. If it were weaker, Earth's atmosphere would lose excessive quantities of water, strangling life.
- If earth's distance from the sun was any greater, the planet would grow very cold, the water cycle in the atmosphere would be affected, and the planet would enter an ice-age. If the Earth were any closer to the Sun, plants would burn up, the water cycle in the Earth's atmosphere would be irreparably damaged, and life would become impossible.
- If the thickness of the ozone layer was any greater, then Earth's temperature would fall enormously. If it were any less, then Earth would overheat and be defenceless against harmful ultraviolet rays.
- If the Earth's inclination angle to its orbit was more than 23 degrees, then the temperature difference between the seasons would reach extreme dimensions, with unbearably hot summers and bitterly cold winters.
- The universe has evidently been established upon the laws of order, regulation and systematic processes.

"It is the work of Allah, who perfected all things." (27:88) Reflect On Your Deen, It's Order, Structure, Balance, Beauty & Your Life "Who remember Allah while standing or sitting or on their sides and give thought to the creation of the heavens and the earth (saying), "Our Lord, You did not create this aimlessly; exalted are You." (3:191)

"All praise is due to Allah, who has sent down upon His Servant the Book and has not made within it any crookedness." (18:1)

"So hold fast to that which is revealed to you. Indeed, you are on a straight path." (43:43)

"Guide us to the straight path" (1:6)

The laws of Islam are divinely planned and miraculously arranged. Salah is prescribed with immense precision and order. Dawn breaks Fajr begins - Sun rises, Fajr elapses. Sun passes its zenith, Zhur enters. When the length of shadows equates to the height of the object Asr enters. Sun sets Maghrib enters. Pitch black over the horizon Isha enters.

"Make your rows straight, stand shoulder to shoulder. Do not leave any gaps for the Shaytan. Whoever completes a row, Allah will reward him, and whoever breaks a row, Allah will forsake him." (Abi Dawud)

Do not precede the Imam, the Imam is to be followed in his actions, his Takbir is followed by yours, his bow by yours...(Bukhari)

- Muslims stand together, bow together, prostrate together, hey stand behind the same Imam, praying towards the same direction. Nizaam
- A similar phenomena occurs for fasting, awaiting Sehri/Iftari, not a second before or after, another remarkable indication of our Deen.
- The same theme of order, regulation and systematic procedure is found in Hajj. The circumambulation around the Kaʿbah is to begin from the black stone and to end at the black stone. Al-Sa'y only 7 bouts must begin from Safa and end at Marwa. Mina, Muzdalifa, Arafah, Jamaraat...
- The roles of the males and females, of husbands and wives have been structured, even the angels have been allocated specific roles. Some are responsible for rain, others are scribes of man's deeds, others are responsible for the blowing of souls within foetuses, others are responsible for claiming the souls, and others are the gatekeepers of Paradise whilst others still are the gatekeepers of Hell. One is responsible for revelation and another is responsible for mountains. Even in this regard, nothing has been left haphazard or without ordering.
 - Islam is a complete way of life that nurtures us to be people of order, discipline and structure, not chaotic, disordered, rash or haphazard.

- Imagine if Allah created this universe without order, system and precision. Imagine a universe of randomness, chaos and disorder, where the sun rises and sets at unpredictable times. The moon comes at random, irregular seasons, fruits, 8 weeks new baby born...
- You purchase a train ticket but the train leaves early, you go to the airport and it's a day late, you record a programme and it's only 5 minutes, you attend a wedding and it's ON TIME.
- What type of life would we be left with? A life of unimaginable physical and psychological suffering.
- Similarly, ask yourself, what type of afterlife will you be left with if you lead a life of disorder, chaos and unplanned schedules?
- An afterlife of unimaginable physical and psychological suffering. Be an ordered, regulated and structured Muslim who follows his biological clock, the system, order or creation, Nizaam, Commands of Allah, Messenger & Deen.
