To look up to the Morals, Ethics, Values, Lessons, Compassion, Mercy, Sunnah of The Prophet Muhammad 
Our eyes should always be fixed to the highest of goals – standards

The Qur'an & Sunnah – Our Deen

Don't get lost in yourself or the Dunya, look above & beyond.

The Prophet  $\Box$  never let his eyes swerve away from Allah  $\Box$ , from the Deen, from the Ummah, from the Pleasure of Allah  $\Box$ .

مَا زَاغَ الْبَصَرُ وَمَا طَغَىٰ لَقَدْ رَأَىٰ مِنْ آيَاتِ رَبِّهِ الْكُبْرَىٰ

The sight [of the Prophet] did not swerve, nor did it transgress [its limit]. He certainly saw of the greatest signs of his Lord.

People of Makkah, Madinah, Muhajireen – Ansaar – Tribes...
