We worry & are eager to please other people. Employer, wife, children, family, friends. But how eager are we to please *al- Malik/*The King, He who possesses the keys to the success of this life & the next? No one is worthier of pleasing & seeking acceptance than Allah. During Ramadan we attempt to please Allah to become His true Servants

TRUE SERVANTS OF ALLAH - THEIR WALK

"And the servants of the Most Merciful are those who walk the earth with humility" No strut, swagger or haughtiness. They realise it is Allah's earth they walk on, His air they breath, His Body they use.

THEIR CHOICE OF WORDS WHEN PROVOKED

"when the ignorant address them [harshly], they say words of peace" They do not meet ignorance with ignorance and insults with insults. Instead their words are reserved for beneficial matters.

THEIR NIGHTS - Whilst others enjoy the comfort of their beds, they dedicate a portion of their nights to bowing, prostrating and calling upon their Lord. "those who spend the night to their Lord prostrating and standing in prayer" وصلوا بالليل والناس نيام ، تدخلوا الجنة بسلام

THEIR DU'A - Despite their righteousness, beautiful speech and prayer at night, they believe in the possibility that they may not make it into paradise. "And those who say, "Our Lord, turn away from us the punishment of Hell. Indeed, its punishment is a permanent one; Indeed, it is evil as a settlement and residence."

THEIR CHARITY – "Those who spend their wealth by night and by day, secretly and publicly - they will have their reward with their Lord. And no fear will there be concerning them, nor will they grieve."

THEIR DISTANCE FROM SINS - "And they are those who do not call with Allah another deity or kill the soul which Allah has forbidden except by right, and do not commit unlawful sexual intercourse. And whoever should do that will meet a penalty.
