And remember Ishmael, Elisha and Dhul-Kifl, and all are among the outstanding. (38:48)

Those were the ones upon whom Allah bestowed favour from among the prophets of the descendants of Adam and of those We carried with Noah, and of the descendants of Abraham and Israel, and of those whom We guided and chose. (19:58)

O Prophet, indeed We have sent you as a witness and a bringer of good tidings and a warner. And one who invites to Allah, by His permission, and an illuminating lamp. (33:45-46)

Throughout history mankind has faced major problems, like bigotry, discrimination, prejudice, conservatism and extremism. The Prophets of Allah and their teachings unite us and we must combine all of their characteristics

“Jesus said, "Indeed, I am the **servant of Allah**. He has given me the **Scripture** and **made me a prophet**. And He has **made me blessed** wherever I am and has **enjoined upon me prayer and zakah** as long as I remain alive. And [made me] **dutiful to my mother**, and He has **not made me a wretched tyrant**. And peace is on me the day I was born and the day I will die and the day I am raised alive. (19:30-33)
