blessed daughter of our Prophet Muhammad 🎉 and Sayyidah Khadijah

"For Muslim men and women, for believing men and women, for devout men and women, for true men and women, for men and women who are patient and constant, for men and women who humble themselves, for men and women who give in charity, for men and women who fast, for men and women who guard their chastity, and for men and women who engage much in Allah's praise, for them has Allah prepared forgiveness and great reward." (33:35)

Sayyidah Fatimah al-Zahra 🙈 married Sayyidna Ali ibn Abu Talib 🦀 and

gave birth to the leaders of Heaven – Imam Hasan and Husain 🙈.

Sayyidah Fatimah al-Zahra was only five years old when the Prophet received revelation, and she therefore grew up in Islam. Our children can also grow up in Islam if we practice our Deen and show them it's beauty. Once the Prophet was doing Sajdah in front of the Ka'bah, the Mushrikeen dumped garbage and animal intestines on him. She immediately ran to her father, but he said "Don't cry O my daughter. Allah will help your father. He will give victory to your father."

- After Khadija and Abu Talib passed away, Sayyidah Fatimah al-Zahra was the one who would cook for him, come to his aid, comfort him. She cared for so much for her father and immersed herself in his character.
- Described by the Prophet **as** as the princess & the leader of the women in Paradise. He **as** would share his deepest feelings and secrets with her.

"My father told me that he would not survive this illness. And then he called me back and told me that I will be the first one to join him."
