- Hijrah of our Hearts to Allah He is capable over everyone and everything. The One who guides, protects, heals, honours, blesses. There is no strength or might except with Allah.
- "whoever holds firmly to Allah, he is indeed guided to the Right Path."
- Hijrah from the Warm Bed Overlook the pleasures and comforts of the world for something greater and everlasting. Seek His Pleasure.
  - "And if Allah touches you with harm, none can remove it but He, and if He touches you with good, then He is Able to do all things." (6:17)
- Hijrah from that Old Dress Imaan is not something that occurs randomly, Imaan increases and decreases, strengthens and weakens, responds to good & evil. Imaan, if not renewed by our words and actions wears away like clothes
  - "Imaan wears out in each and every one of you like a garment wears out, so ask Allah ## the most high to renew the Imaan in our hearts."
