

- When we have an exam, test, interview, anniversary, appointments, birthdays, flights, we stress, become anxious, worry, loose sleep we can't afford to & never forget these important events.
- But we easily forget what we heard last Jumu'ah! The suffering of our brothers & sisters. We forget YAWMUL HISAAB, where Divine Justice shall be done. The world is looking to the ICC for HISAAB...
  - A Day that will make the children white-haired? (73:17) On the Day a man will flee from his brother, mother & father, wife & children (80:34-36) That is the True Day of reality (78:39)
- On the Day you will see every nursing mother forget her baby, every pregnant female will miscarry, you will think people are drunk when they are not, so severe will be God's torment. (22:2)
- Despite declaring with our tongues, how many prepare for YAWMUL HISAAB with our actions?
- Insaan is forgetful Nisyaan our forgetful nature can be praiseworthy or blameworthy.
- PRAISEWORTHY when you forget people's evil to you faults pain debt & move on
- BLAMEWORTHY when we forget Allah # He is watching His Blessings His Huqooq His Hisaab
- **BLAMEWORTHY** that there is a day where you will stand before Allah & & be held accountable
- **BLAMEWORTHY** when we forget our brothers & sisters in Palestine, Yemen, Syria...

- Forgetting YAWMUL HISAAB leads us to disrespect our parents, betray our Deen, Ummah & trusts, cheat our spouse, buy & sell Haram, seize land/inheritance, take bribes & interest, not wear hijab...
- The one day we cannot afford to forget is YAWMUL HISAAB YET WE DO.
  - Indeed, those who go astray from the way of Allah will have a severe punishment for having forgotten the Day of Account. (38:26) Today we will forget you, because you forgot the day of this meeting. Your abode will be the hellfire where none will help you (45:34)
- DO NOT FORGET 15.05.1948 Nakba, Land Grab, Raping, Incarcerations, Inhumane Treatment, Harassment, Apartheid, Wars, Bombs, Hospitals, Schools, Genocide, Killings, Destruction.
- **DO NOT FORGET From the river to the sea Palestine will be free**
- DO NOT FORGET A group of people from my Ummah will continue to fight in defence of truth and remain triumphant until the Day of judgment. (Muslim)
- **DO NOT FORGET** The first matters to be judged between people will be cases of murder (Bukhari)
- DO NOT FORGET The countries that continue to supply arms & give unrelenting support
- **DO NOT FORGET** Where you will be accountable not just for yourself but others
- DO NOT FORGET The Vetoes at UN, the hypocrisy, failure to ceasefire & recognise Palestine
- The reckoning of people's judgment has drawn near, yet they are heedlessly turning away. (21:1-2)

- 1445 years ago, Allah said the day of accountability is near however the love & addiction of Dunya keeps us heedless of that day which is fast approaching YAWMUL HISAAB.
- **DO NOT FORGET The upcoming elections DO NOT FORGET Boycotts Lies Betrayal**
- The people of Palestine have not forgotten & they are eager to meet their Lord for their HISAAB.
- Are you ready? Most of us are oblivious of YAWMUL HISAAB where everything will be exposed!
  - On that Day you will be brought to judgement, none of your secrets will remain hidden. The Day when secrets will be put on trial (86:9) That Day, We will seal over their mouths, and their hands will speak to Us, and their feet will testify about what they used to do (36:65)
- Impossible for any Muslim who believes in YAWMUL HISAAB to ignore the suffering, plight, genocide, destruction, starvation, the loss of humanity...
- How can Muslims close & block their borders? How can Muslim leaders sit back and allow this all to unfold. How can Muslims continue to trade with them?
- Muslims leaders are accountable they can make a change, they can hold them to account, but they have forgotten YAWMUL HISAAB & are doing next to nothing.
- Gaza, Rafah, Yemen, is happening because we have FORGOTTON YAWMUL HISAAB
  - And fear a Day when you will be returned to Allah. Then every soul will be compensated for what it earned, and they will not be treated unjustly. (2:281) And Your Lord Never Forgets (19:64)
