Whenever a Muslim greets you, we reply with this Du'aa of love and peace. We also shake their right hand or hug them.

Fee A Maa Nil Laah

Go with Allaah's protection

We say this Du'aa when someone is leaving and going away.

مَعَ السَّلَامَةِ

Ma 'As Sa Laa Mah

Go in the safety of Allaah

BEGINNINGS

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

A 'Oo Dhu Bil Laa He, Me Nash Shay Taa Nir Ra Jeem

I seek the protection of Allaah from the cursed Satan

When we are afraid, or angry, or when we want to get rid of a bad feeling or anything evil, then we read this Du'aa for Allaah's protection from the devil. We also read this for protection before beginning the Qur'aan.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Bis Mil Laa Hir Rah Maa Nir Ra Heem

I begin in the name of Allah, the most kind, the most merciful

Before we start anything Muslims always read this Du'aa so Allaah can bless us and makes it good for us. Before reading the Qur'aan, Wudu, Eating, Drinking, Travelling etc.

EVERYDAY OCCASIONS

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ

Al Ham Du Lil Laah

All praise is for Allaah

We always say this to thank Allaah for everything good. We also say this when we sneeze as Allaah takes away all the germs from our nose.

يَرْحَمُكَ اللَّهُ

Yar Ha Mu Kil Laah

May Allaah have mercy on you (girl/female)

يَرْحَمَكَ اللَّهُ

Yar Ha Mu Kal Laah

May Allaah have mercy on you (boy/male)

When a Muslim sneezes and says "Al Ham Du Lil Laah", then we reply and say this Du'aa.

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ

Sub Haa Nal Laah

Glory is to Allaah

إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ

In Shaa Allaah

If Allaah wills

Whenever we make a promise or intend to do something in the future, then we make this Du'aa and ask for Allaah's help to complete it.

مَا شَاءَ اللَّهُ

Maa Shaa Allaah

Whatever Allaah willed

Whenever we see something beautiful or nice we say this Du'aa. We also say this when we are happy, or hear some good news or compliment someone.

Ja Zaa Kil Laa Hu Khay Ran

May Allaah reward you (girl/female)

We say this Du'aa when we want to thank someone for anything nice they have said or done.

بَارَكَ اللَّهُ فِيكَ

Baa Ra Kal Laa Hu Fee Ke

May Allaah bless you (girl/female)

بَارَكَ اللَّهُ فِيكَ

Baa Ra Kal Laa Hu Fee Ka

May Allaah bless you (boy/male)

أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ

As Tagh Fe Rul Laah

I seek Allaah's forgiveness

When we see anything wrong or bad, then we say this Du'aa. We also say this when we feel sorry about something we have thought about, or said or done.

اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ

Allaah Hu Akbar

Allaah is the greatest

رَبِّ زِدْنِي عِلْمًا

Rab Be Zid Nee 'il Maa

O My Lord (Allaah) increase me in knowledge

This Du'aa from the Qur'aan teaches that Allaah loves those who study hard and practice what they learn. Knowledge is a light to success and benefits those who learn it and practice it.

SLEEPING AND WAKING UP

بِسْمِكَ اللَّهُمَّ أَمُوتُ وَأَحْيَا

Bis Me Kal Laa Hum Ma, A Muu Tu, Wa Ah Yaa

O Allaah, in your name I live and i die

We read this Du'aa so Allaah protects us and forgives us before we sleep. We remind ourselves that this life is a gift from Allaah, so we must do good actions to make Allaah happy.

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَحْيَانَا بَعْدَ مَا أَمَاتَنَا وَإِلَيْهِ النُّشُورُ

Al Ham Du Lil Laa Hil La The, Ah Yaa Naa, Ba' Da Maa A Maa Ta Naa, Wa E Lay Hin Nu Shoor

All praise is for Allah who returned life to us after death (sleep) and to Him is the return

We read this Du'aa when we wake up to remind ourselves that Allaah is the one who allows us to wake up and returns life to our bodies. He is the one who gives us life and death and changes day and night. We thank Allah for giving us another day to live and do good actions.

ENTERING AND EXITING THE TOILET

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْخُبْثِ وَالْخُبَائِثِ

***Allaah Hum Ma, in Nee A 'Uu Dhu Be Ka, Me Nal Khu Bu The,
Wal Kha Baa ith***

O Allaah, I seek your protection against all filth and evil

Islam is a religion of purity for the body, clothes, mind, heart and soul. It is important that when we go to the toilet we must take care to keep our clothes and body clean and protect our heart and mind from evil by reading this Du'aa.

I seek your pardon; all praise is to Allaah who removed discomfort from me and gave me relief

We ask Allaah to forgive us for our mistakes and for any impurities on our body and clothes. We also ask protection from any evil in the toilet that may affect our mind, heart and soul.

EATING AND DRINKING

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَعَلَى بَرَكَاتِهِ

Bis Mil Laa He, Wa 'Alaa Ba Ra Ka Til Laah

I begin in the name and blessings of Allaah

Before we eat or drink anything we always wash our hands then read this Du'aa. This reminds us that food and water comes from Allaah and is a great blessing which we must be grateful for. If we do not read this Du'aa then the devil also eats and drinks with us, so the food and drink loses all its blessings.

IF YOU FORGET THE DU'AA BEFORE EATING AND DRINKING

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ أَوَّلَهُ وَآخِرَهُ

Bis Mil Laa He, Aw Wa La Hu, Wa Aa Khe Ra Hu

In Allaah's name at the beginning and at the end

Sometimes we are in such a hurry to eat that we forget to read the Du'aa at the beginning of the meal. By reading this Du'aa all the blessings and rewards in the food and drink return from Allaah. Anything that the devil has eaten or drank is vomited out by him when you read this Du'aa.

All praise is to Allaah who gave us food and drink and made us Muslims

It's important to thank Allaah at the end of the meal so that Allaah is happy and gives us more food and drink in the future.
