WHEN DOING WUDU

اللَّهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِي ذَنْبِي وَوَسِّعْ لِي فِي دَارِي وَبَارِكْ لِي فِي رِزْقِي

**Allaah Hum Magh Fir Lee Dhanb Bee, Wa Was Si' Lee Fee Daa Ree,
Wa Baa Rik Lee Fee Riz Qee**

O Allaah, forgive my sins, give me abundance in my home and bless me in what you have given me

The Prophet Muhammad once explained that our sins are washed away when we make Wudu just as dead leaves fall from a tree when it is shaken. If we take care and make Wudu carefully with a sincere intention then we can wash away all our sins and get a pure body and heart.

WHEN COMPLETING WUDU

I witness that there is no god but Allaah. He is one and has no partner. And I witness that Muhammad is His servant and messenger. O Allaah, make me from the people who repent often and from those who keep themselves pure

When we finish our Wudu we refresh and renew our faith by saying this Du'aa. We remind ourselves that the purpose of Wudu and worship is to become true servants of Allaah and followers of the Prophet Muhammad.

WHEN GETTING DRESSED

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي كَسَانِي هَذَا الثَّوْبَ وَرَزَقَنِيهِ مِنْ غَيْرِ حَوْلٍ مِنِّي وَلَا قُوَّةَ

Al Ham Du Lil Laa Hil La Thee Ka Saa Nee Ha Zhas Thaw Ba

Wa Ra Za Qa Nee He, Min Ghay Re Haw Lim Min Nee Wa Laa Quw Wah

All praise is for Allaah who gave me clothes to cover my body and to live a beautiful life

Clothing not only covers our naked body from other people but also protects us from the heat, cold, rain and wind. It also gives us honour, respect and makes us look and live a beautiful life We thank Allaah every time we wear clothes as many people in the world do not have much clothes.

WHEN LOOKING IN THE MIRROR

O Allaah just as you have made me beautiful; make my character beautiful as well

Unlike people, Allaah does not judge us by our bodies, but He looks at our hearts, our behaviour and manners. Regardless of how we look, we should always make our character the most beautiful.

WHEN BREAKING OUR FAST

O Allaah, I fasted for you, I believe in you and I am breaking my fast with what you have provided for me, so forgive me

When we fast on Mondays and Thursday or in the month of Ramadan, after reading Bis Mil Laah we should also read this Du'aa like the Prophet Muhammad used to.

WHEN ENTERING THE HOME

In the name of Allaah we leave and enter the home, and we rely and depend upon our Lord

WHEN LEAVING THE HOME

In the name of Allaah (I leave), placing my trust in Allaah, there is no power or strength except with Allaah

When we leave the safety of our homes, we remember Allaah, rely on him, and seek his protection from all evil, harm and challenges in the world.

**Sub Haa Nal La The Sakh Kha Ra La Naa Ha Zha, Wa Maa Kun Naa La Hu
Muq Re Neen, Wa in Naa E Laa Rab Be Naa La Mun Qa Le Boon**

All glory is for (Allaah) who made it possible for us to master this transport for our own needs, for we would never be able to accomplish it on our own. And we will all surely return to our Lord.

This prayer reminds us that Allaah has given us the intelligence and power to control animals, vehicles and other forms of transport to travel. It is a great blessing and favour of Allaah which we should be grateful for. We also remind ourselves that one day the journey of our life will end and we will return to Allaah, so we should also prepare for that as well and not get distracted by the journeys of the world.

In the name of Allah, is its moving and its stopping. Most certainly my Lord is the most forgiving and most merciful.

WHEN RETURNING HOME FROM A JOURNEY

آيِبُونَ تَائِبُونَ عَابِدُونَ لِرَبِّنَا حَامِدُونَ

Aa Ye Boon, Taa E Boon, 'Aa Be Doon, Le Rab Be Naa Haa Me Doon

We return repenting, worshipping and praising our Lord (Allaah)

When we reach the safety and comfort of our home after a long journey, we show our gratitude to Allaah and repent of any sins we may have done during the journey. We praise him and thank him for returning us back home to our family and loves ones.

WHEN ENTERING A CITY / TOWN

WHEN ANYTHING BAD HAPPEN OR A LOSS OCCURS

Indeed we all belong to Allah and to Him is our return

TO PROTECT YOURSELF FROM ALL EVIL AND HARM

In the Name of Allah with Whose Name there is protection against every kind of harm in the earth and in the heaven, and He is the All-Hearing and All- Knowing

Read this three times in the morning when you wake up and nothing throughout the day can harm you. Also read this three times before you go to sleep and nothing can harm you throughout the night.

WHEN IN DIFFICULTY

حَسْبُنَا اللَّهُ وَنِعْمَ الْوَكِيلُ

Has Bu Nal Laa Hu Wa N'i Mal Wa Keel

Allaah is sufficient for us and He is the best helper

Saying this prayer when we are in difficulties reminds us to turn to Allaah for help, for He is the most powerful and can help us. With strong faith in Allaah, and courage we can overcome any problem and difficulty in life.

WHEN SOMEONE IS SICK

لَا بَأْسَ طُهُورٌ إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ

La Ba-sa Tu Huu Ran In Shaa Allaah

Do not worry; this will purify you by the will of Allaah

Sick people sometimes worry that they might not get better. Even when a person is very ill, the prophet Muhammad advised us to try and cheer them up. We say this Du'aa to remind ourselves and those who are sick that every illness no matter how small or big will purify a Muslim of their sins and they will get closer to Allaah and to their family and friends.

ALLAAH

سُبْحَانَهُ وَتَعَالَى

Sub Haa Na Hu Wa Ta 'Aa Laa

Glory is for Allaah the most high

Whenever the name of Allaah is mentioned, Muslims always say this to show respect and honour to Allaah. This expression also means that Allaah is pure, has no partners and is the most high. He is exalted from having a son". Muslims believe that Allah is the only God, the Creator of the Universe. He does not have partners or children.

عَزَّ وَجَلَّ

Az Za Wa Jal

The Mighty and Majestic

Whenever the name of Allaah is mentioned, Muslims always say this to show respect and honour to Allaah. The word 'Azza' is derived from 'Izzah', which means might and power and the word 'Jalla' is derived from Al-Jalaal, which means greatness and reverence. Therefore, the term Azza wa Jalla is an attribute of Allaah which means that He is the Owner of Greatness and Reverence and that He is The Most Strong who is never defeated.

MUHAMMAD

صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ

Sal Lal Laa Hu 'Alay He Wa Sallam

May the peace and blessings of Allaah be upon the him (Muhammad)

Whenever the name of Prophet Muhammad is mentioned, Muslims always say this to show respect and honour to the Prophet Muhammad. It is a prayer asking Allaah to send peace and blessings upon the Prophet Muhammad.

Whenever the name of any Prophet – Messenger – Angel or respectful woman is mentioned then Muslims say this Du'a as a sign of respect and honour. The prayer means, may the peace of Allaah be upon him/her.
