22nd of Jumada al-Aakhira marks the death date of Abu Bakr al-Siddiq رضي الله عنه.

“We have surely repaid any favour done upon us by anyone, except Abu Bakr. For he has a contribution [to Islam] that only Allah can repay on the Day of Judgement” (Tirmidhi)

The First - Abu Bakr means **‘the one to act quickest’** - He was the First adult to become a Muslim. First to read Salah with the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم. First of the ten promised Paradise. First to preserve the Qur’an. First to memorise the Qur’an. First & only to be given the title Al-Siddiq. First Khalifah in Islam. First to enter Jannah, after the Messenger صلى الله عليه وسلم.

Naturally Guided - Abu Bakr al-Siddiq even before the appearance of Islam he was a model Muslim. He refrained from alcohol, never cheated people, never lied and never bowed to idols.

Recorded in the Qur’an - **إِذْ يَقُولُ لِصَاحِبِهِ لَا تَحْزَنْ إِنَّ اللَّهَ مَعَنَا - الَّذِي يُؤْتِي مَالَهُ يَتَزَكَّى**

Good Qualities – “The excellent traits are 360; when Allah wants good for a person then He blesses him with one, by which he enters Jannah.’ Abu Bakr asked, ‘O Messenger of Allah! Do I have any of these traits?’ He replied; ‘Yes O Abu Bakr! All of them”

Honesty, humility, benefiting others, kindness, being fearful of Allah and being generous are all good, praiseworthy traits. So don't belittle one good thing you have. One is enough to enter you into Jannah, but Abu Bakr al-Siddiq رضي الله عنه had all according to the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم.

Companionship – Suhba - Abu Bakr al-Siddiq رضي الله عنه was the Companion of the Prophet in his youth, in Makkah, in al-Madinah, in travels, at home, at the mosque, in the battlefield and even in the afterlife. Before he left this world, Abu Bakr al-Siddiq رضي الله عنه asked his Companions to place his body next to the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم. If the door opened itself miraculously, then he was to be buried next to the Messenger. If the door remained shut, he was to be buried in Jannat al-Baqi.

“Allah has favoured the Prophets, the truthful, the martyrs and the righteous. And how excellent are those as companions.” (4:69)
