WITHOUT RECONCILIATION WE CAN NEVER BE STRONG/GROW

"Be mindful of Allah and reconcile between yourselves and obey Allah and His Messenger, if you are believers." (8:1)

The believers are brothers, so reconcile between your brothers, and remain conscious of God, so that you may receive mercy. (49:10)

Shall I not inform you of something more excellent in degree than fasting, prayer & sadaqah? The people replied: Yes, Prophet of Allah! It is reconciliation: putting things right between people, and beware of spoiling relations with each other – it strips you – haaliqah- shaves the Deen. (Abu Dawud)

RECONCILIATION BETTER THAN PRAYER, FASTING AND CHARITY?

If the reconciliation is to prevent murder, broken marriages, child abuse, Fitna, then it is more important than praying the Salah immediately.

HAALIQAHAH – THE RAZOR - Prophetic comparison of **Reconciliation** to **Spoiling Relations** to **Shaving Deen**. When you have hatred, it leads to insulting someone, being violent or even kill someone, so it destroys people, society & religion. **“Make peace between each other. For indeed spoiling relations with each other is the Haaliqah (the razor).”** (Tirmidhi)

UNITING HEARTS - *Remember Allah’s favour upon you when you were enemies, then He united your hearts, so by His grace you became brothers. You were at the brink of a fiery pit & He saved you. (3:103)*

When you reach a position where you do not want reconciliation, you are going down shaytan’s path. Each time you choose division it will affect you, your religion, your family, and your community. This is why it ‘shaves off’ a bit of the religion. Religion is based on cooperation not division.

MARRIAGE RECONCILIATION - Prophet ﷺ, Abdullah Ibn Umar رضي الله عنه
